STRATEGIC COMMUNICATIONS

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BUCKET BATTLE NEXT AT ROSS-ADE

• Purdue Football (7-4, 5-3 BIG) returns home for Senior Day at Ross-Ade Stadium, hosting in-state foe Indiana on Saturday, Nov. 27, for the annual Old Oaken Bucket Game. Kickoff is scheduled for 3:30 p.m. ET on FS1.

• A total of 16 Boilermakers will be recognized on Senior Day on Saturday in a pregame ceremony. Head coach Jeff Brohm allows Purdue student-athletes to have the option of participating in Senior Day ahead of any decision-making process related to eligibility that may occur following the completion of the season.

• Saturday's Purdue-Indiana game is sold out, the second official sellout at Ross-Ade Stadium this season alongside the Wisconsin game (Oct. 23).

• With the Indiana game (Nov. 27) sellout, Purdue will finish the 2021 season with an average home attendance of 56,333, which is the most at Ross-Ade Stadium since the 2008 season.

ABOUT THE OLD OAKEN BUCKET

• While Saturday's game will be the 123rd meeting between the Boilermakers and Hoosiers, this year's matchup will be just the 96th edition of the Old Oaken Bucket Game.

• Since 1925, Purdue and Indiana have played annually for the Old Oaken Bucket. The Boilermakers lead the Bucket portion of the all-time series 60-32-3, including 15 wins in the last 23 showdowns.

• Purdue has won two of the three matchups under head coach Jeff Brohm. This year's game returns following the cancellation of the 2020 game due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

• The Chicago alumni groups of both schools came up with the idea for a traveling trophy, and Russell Gray of Purdue and Clarence Jones of Indiana were given the task of finding an appropriate object. They recommended that "an old oaken bucket would be a most typical trophy from this state and should be taken from a well somewhere in Indiana." Purdue's Fritz Ernst and Whitley J. Huddle of Indiana found the fabled bucket, in a bad state of repair, covered with moss and mold, on the Bruner farm between Kent and Hanover in southern Indiana.

• The Bruner farm was settled in the 1840s, and family lore suggests the bucket might have been used by Confederate General John Hunt Morgan and his soldiers during their incursion into Indiana in 1863 during the Civil War.

• George Ade, distinguished humorist from Purdue, and Harry Kurrie, president of the Monon Railroad, representing Indiana, formally introduced the Old Oaken Bucket in 1925. The Boilermakers and Hoosiers subsequently battled to a 0-0 tie Nov. 21 at Ross-Ade Stadium, resulting in an "I-P" link being attached to the bucket.

• Throughout its history, the bucket has been kidnapped by partisans from both schools – a couple of times missing so long that it was given up as lost, only to turn up mysteriously just before or after the annual game.

ON THE LINE

• The Boilermakers have the opportunity against Indiana to win their eighth game of the regular season, an accomplishment that has not occurred for the Old Gold & Black since 2006.

• In 2006, former head coach Joe Tiller's Purdue squad went 8-5 during its regular season schedule before dropping its final game to Maryland in the Sun Bowl (Dec. 29, 2006).

• Dating back to 2000, Purdue has won eight games in an overall season four times, all during the Tiller era (2000, 2003, 2006, 2007).

• Purdue is also seeking a sixth victory in Big Ten play, which would be the most since Joe Tiller's 2003 Boilermakers went 6-2 to tie for second in the conference standings.

• Junior WR David Bell was named a finalist for the prestigious Biletnikoff Award on Tuesday, Nov. 23, an honor annually "received" by college football's outstanding FBS receiver.

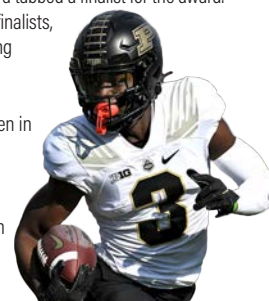
• Any player, regardless of position (WR, TE, SB and RB) who catches a pass is eligible for the award. With the season that Bell is having (87 receptions, 1,207 yards, five touchdowns), he is certainly eligible.

• Bell joins former Purdue standout WR Taylor Stubblefield (2004) as the only Boilermakers to be a tabbed a finalist for the award.

• Among the fellow Biletnikoff finalists, Bell leads the group in receiving yards vs. Top 25 competitions at 624 yards.

• Bell currently leads the Big Ten in both receiving yards and receptions (120.7 yards and 8.7 catches per game).

• Bell ranks fourth nationally in receiving yards per game and third in receptions per game.

WINNING NOTES

• Head coach Jeff Brohm's Boilermakers claimed their fifth league victory with the 32-14 win against Northwestern (Nov. 20), getting to the five-win mark in Big Ten action for the first time since 2018 and just the fifth time since the 2000 season.

• The Boilermakers won their fourth away game of the season with the win at Northwestern, a home game for the Wildcats at Wrigley Field. To find a Purdue squad with more road wins, one must search back to 1943, when Elmer Burnham's band of Boilermakers went 9-0 on the season with a 5-0 away record.

NUMBERS TO KNOW DOWN THE STRETCH

• The Boilermakers have made their presence known all across the college football landscape this season.
• The following numbers are the most important to remember:

- 1: QB Aidan O'Connell is No. 1 in Big Ten in comp. pct. at 72.7.
- 2: Purdue has two Top-5 wins for the first time since 1960.
- 3: Bowl-eligible for third time under head coach Jeff Brohm.
- 3: Three, again, #3 WR David Bell is a Biletnikoff semifinalist.
- 5: DE George Karlaftis, #5, is a Bednarik semifinalist.
- 6: O'Connell with 74.0+ pct. comp. in six-straight games.
- 10: S Cam Allen, #10, tied for third in Big Ten for INTs (4).
- 13: Past 6 games: 13 takeaways. Two total in first 5 games.
- 40: Bell has 40 catches against Top-25 teams this season.
- 624: Bell has 624 receiving yards in those games, as well.
- 1,207: Bell has 1,207 rec. yards in 2021, 5th in Purdue history.

BEST RIVALRY PERFORMANCES

• When a rivalry game has been played 122 times since 1891, there is bound to be some big games by Purdue as a team and by individual Boilermakers. Here are some of the top Purdue performances throughout the history of the rivalry with Indiana.

• Most Points (68 - 1892): In just the second meeting between the programs, Purdue rolled to a 68-0 victory which still stands as the largest margin of victory in the rivalry.

• Most Rushing Yards (272 - Otis Armstrong): Seven Boilermakers have rushed for more than 200 yards against the Hoosiers, and Otis Armstrong leads the way. The Purdue running back chalked up 272 yards on the ground in 1972, leading the team to a 42-7 victory.

• Most Passing Yards (522 - Kyle Orton): Heisman Trophy candidate Kyle Orton made his final game at Ross-Ade Stadium a memorable one, throwing for 522 yards and six touchdowns in a 63-24 victory over the Hoosiers in 2004. He tallied 401 yards and five touchdowns in the first half alone, leading the Boilermakers to an easy win.

• Most Receiving Yards (209 - Kyle Ingraham): One of Orton's favorite targets in the 2004 version of the Old Oaken Bucket Game was Kyle Ingraham, who hauled in 11 catches for 209 yards and a pair of touchdowns. Not to be forgotten that day was Taylor Stubblefield's record-setting performance. His 14 catches for 138 yards gave him 309 career receptions, an NCAA record at the time.

SINGLE-SEASON RECORD WATCH

• The Boilermakers have completed 354 passes on the season, just 23 shy of the school record (377) set in 1998.

• Purdue is 403 yards away from the school record of passing yards in a single season (4,208-1998)

• Fifth-year senior QB Aidan O'Connell is currently on pace to destroy the school record for completion percentage by a Purdue quarterback; the fifth-year senior has completed 72.7 percent of his passes (263-362), well above David Blough's record of 66.0 percent (305-462) in 2018.

• Junior WR David Bell (1,207) needs 101 yards to set a new Purdue record for receiving yards in a single season; John Standeford's 2002 season (1,307) remains the top mark for now.

BOWL BOUND

• With its sixth win of the season against Michigan State (Nov. 6), Purdue became bowl eligible for first time since 2018.

• The Boilermakers will be bowl bound for the third time in five seasons under Jeff Brohm.

BEDNARIK SEMIFINALIST FOR GEORGE

• Junior DE George Karlaftis was named a semifinalist for the Chuck Bednarik Award on Monday, Nov. 1, an honor annually bestowed upon the college football defensive player of the year.

• Prior to the season, Karlaftis was named to watch lists for the Lott Trophy, Bednarik Award and Nagurski Trophy. In 26 career collegiate games, Karlaftis has 25.5 tackles-for-loss and 12.5 sacks.

• In the win over Northwestern at Wrigley Field, Nov. 20, Karlaftis blocked the first field goal of his career; it was the first field goal blocked by a Boilermaker since 2018 against Michigan State.

AIR IT OUT, AIDAN

• The most accurate passer, currently, in the Big Ten Conference is Purdue signal caller Aidan O'Connell. The fifth-year senior QB is completing 72.7 percent of his throws (263-362), while averaging 26.3 completions per game. Both marks rank fifth nationally.

• Over his last six games, O'Connell is completing more than 75.0 percent of his pass attempts (.752, 197-262). Since the 2000 season, O'Connell is the only Purdue quarterback to string together three consecutive games above the 74.0-percent mark, let alone the current six-game span.

• In games against Top 5 competition (at No. 2 Iowa, No. 3 Michigan State, and at No. 4 Ohio State), O'Connell has thrown for 1,301 passing yards (433.7 avg.) and completed 110-of-146 pass attempts (.753). For those three games, O'Connell has a 9-0 TD-INT ratio.

• O'Connell passed for 423 yards in the win over Northwestern, Nov. 20, becoming just sixth Purdue quarterback to have multiple 400-yard games in a single season. He joined Drew Brees, who accomplished the feat three times in his historic career (1998-2000), as well as Boilermaker quarterbacks Jim Everett (1985), Curtis Painter (2006), David Blough (2016) and Elijah Sindelar (2019).

RING THE BELL

• If you hadn't heard of junior WR David Bell before the Iowa game (Oct. 16) or the Michigan State game (Nov. 6), now you have. The junior from Indianapolis (Warren Central HS) torched the No. 2 Hawkeyes for 240 receiving yards (11 catches), the second-highest yardage total in team history, behind only Chris Daniels' 301 vs. Michigan State (October 16, 1999).

• Bell led the team with 217 receiving yards on 11 catches with a TD in the victory over No. 5/3 Michigan State (Nov. 6), with those 217 receiving yards standing as the fifth-most in school history.

• With the Iowa and MSU efforts, Bell is the second player in program history with multiple 200-plus-yard receiving games, along with Brian Alford (215 and 209, both in 1979).

• Bell has surpassed 100 receiving yards in 17 of his 28 career games at Purdue. When Bell passed the 100-yard mark vs. the Spartans, he broke the school record with his 15th career 100-yard game.

• Also within the Iowa game was a season-long 60-yard snag for Bell, which is the longest play from scrimmage for the Boilermakers in 2021. His longest is an 89-yard touchdown reception vs. Nebraska during the 2020 season (Dec. 5).

- Bell started his 2021 campaign with a 134-yard, eight-catch effort vs. Oregon State (Sept. 4) and a 121-yard, six-catch, three-touchdown outing at UConn (Sept. 11).
- Bell missed the Illinois (Sept. 25) game due to being in concussion protocol after the Notre Dame (Sept. 18) game.
- The Boilermaker star ranks fourth nationally in receiving yards per game (120.7), and first in the Big Ten Conference.
- For his career, Bell is averaging an FBS-leading 102.4 receiving yards per game. His 8.1 receptions per game is currently the 2nd-most for an active NCAA career.
- Bell is just 101 yards away from setting a new school record for yards in a single season.
- The three-TD game for Bell at UConn matched his career-high he set against Iowa last season (Oct. 24, 2020). He is just the second Purdue WR in school history with multiple three-TD reception games, joining Taylor Stubblefield (2001-04).

THE PRICE IS WRIGHT

- Junior wide receiver Milton Wright had a career day against Northwestern at Wrigley Field (Nov. 20), hauling in eight receptions for 213 yards and three touchdowns to earn career highs in all three categories.
- The performance was Wright's first multi-touchdown game of his career, and he joined David Bell as Boilermaker wide receivers recording a trio of receiving touchdowns in a game this season. In fact, only four other Big Ten receivers have scored at least three touchdowns in a game during the 2021 campaign.
- Wright's performance also marked the sixth time a Big Ten receiver put together a 200-yard game this season. Three of those were by Boilermakers (Bell-2, Wright-1), the first time in school history that Purdue had three 200-yard games from receivers in a single season.
- Wright eclipsed the 100-yard plateau in the first half (five catches, 101 yards), securing his second 100-yard game as a Boilermaker.

WE HAVE LIFT OFF

- Fifth-year senior QB Aidan O'Connell absolutely torched the visiting Spartans on Saturday, Nov. 6, throwing for a career-best 536 yards on 40-of-54 passing with three scores to lead the Boilermakers to a 40-29 upset victory.
- Throwing for 423 yards to help lead the Boilermakers to a win over Northwestern (Nov. 20), O'Connell became the seventh quarterback in Purdue history to produce at least five 300-yard games in a season and the first since David Blough (2016). The effort was the eighth 300-yard passing game for O'Connell in his Purdue career, moving into a tie with Mark Herrmann for fifth on the all-time list.
- O'Connell was fantastic in the win at No. 2 Iowa (Oct. 16), throwing for 375 yards on 30-40-0 passing, including two passing TDs and one rushing score. O'Connell was recognized as one of the Davey O'Brien Award's "Great 8" quarterbacks on Monday, Oct. 18.
- The effort by O'Connell at Northwestern (Nov. 20) was the 24th 300-yard passing performance during head coach Jeff Brohm's tenure with the Boilermakers.

WELCOME TO THE PURDUE PICK PARTY

- Purdue has now had two games with four interceptions this season after not recording a four-INT game since the 2018 season. Prior to the four INTs by Purdue's defense at No. 2 Iowa (Oct. 16) and the most recent effort at Nebraska (Oct. 30), the Boilermakers last had four interceptions vs. Boston College on Sept. 22, 2018.
- The Boilermakers have accomplished a four-interception game eight times in the last 21 seasons of football, but 2021 stands as the first season since 1999 with two instances in the same campaign.

MORE BELL RINGING

- Junior WR David Bell has put together a Top 10 receiving career at Purdue, as he ranks in the school's all-time Top 10 for receptions (4th), receiving yards (5th) and receiving touchdowns (7th).
- Heading into 2021, Bell was named to the watch lists for Maxwell Award (most outstanding player) and Biletnikoff Award (outstanding receiver). He was the 2019 Big Ten Freshman of the Year and also picked up first-team all-conference honors.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS

- Junior LB Jalen Graham's second-quarter interception at Nebraska (Oct. 30) was returned 45 yards for a touchdown, becoming the first Purdue pick-six since Cory Trice's 37-yard return on October 12, 2019, vs. Maryland.
- Graham's performance at Nebraska, which included two interceptions, helped him earn Big Ten Conference Defensive Player of the Week, announced on Monday, Nov. 1
- Junior DE George Karlaftis' fumble return for a touchdown in the second half vs. Wisconsin (Oct. 23) was the first by a Boilermaker since Graham on October 31, 2020, at Illinois.
- With Karlaftis' play, Purdue has now had a fumble or interception returned for score by its defense for eight consecutive seasons.

GOODBYE, NUMBER TWO

- With the win against No. 2 Iowa (Oct. 16), Purdue improved to 6-10 all-time against teams ranked No. 2 in the AP poll, and the Boilermakers have won two in a row, including the 49-20 win against second-ranked Ohio State on October 20, 2018
- The Iowa win is Purdue's first against a top-2 foe on the road since a 31-20 victory at Notre Dame on September 28, 1974.

JAYLAN'S JURISDICTION

- Since the 2000 season, just five Boilermakers have accumulated 15 or more tackles in a game. With his effort against Wisconsin (Oct. 23), senior LB Jaylan Alexander became the latest to accomplish the feat (11 solo, 4 assisted, 10 TFL).
- In recent memory, former LBs Ben Holt and Markus Bailey make the list provided by Sports-Reference.com. Holt recorded 17 tackles in 2019 against TCU (Sept. 14, 2019), while Bailey posted 15 stops in 2018 in the win against No. 2 Ohio State (Oct. 20, 2018).

• Alexander, leading Purdue in tackles, is tied for 11th in the Big Ten Conference, currently, with his 77 total stops (7.7 per game).

A WHOLE NEW (CFP) ERA

- Purdue Football entered the College Football Playoff rankings at No. 19 on Tuesday, Nov. 9. The ranking was the first-ever in the CFP era for the Boilermakers.
- Head coach Jeff Brohm's squad (6-3, 4-2) earned an Associated Press Top 25 ranking earlier this season after the upset win over No. 2-ranked Iowa (Oct. 16) to improve to 4-2 (2-1). Following the Boilermakers' big win over No. 3-ranked Michigan State (Nov. 6), Purdue ascended into the latest set of CFP rankings.

CENTURY MARK

- Under head coach Jeff Brohm's leadership, Purdue has seen 33 games with at least one student-athlete topping 100 yards receiving, including nine games with two Boilermakers over the century mark and one with three different players.

FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 1960

- Purdue has beaten two AP Top-5 teams for the first time since 1960, when it beat No. 3 Ohio State and No. 1 Minnesota.
- Former head coach Jack Mollenkopf's Boilers defeated the Buckeyes by a score of 24-21 (Oct. 15, 1960) and went on the road to top the top-ranked Gophers, 23-14 (Nov. 12, 1960).

LINE THEM UP, KNOCK THEM DOWN

- The last season Purdue beat two or more Top-25 teams in a season was 2018, with three, and the last time Purdue upended two top-10 teams was in 1984 (No. 8 Notre Dame, 23-21 and No. 2 Ohio State 28-23).
- Purdue has 17 wins against AP Top-5 foes as an unranked team, which is the most in the country by six, ahead of Illinois and USC's 11 and Michigan State's 10.

NEW LOOK DEFENSE

- Purdue's defense is led by a new array of assistant coaches selected to join the Boilermaker staff by head coach Jeff Brohm during the offseason leading up to the 2021 season. Three new co-defensive coordinators were hired, Brad Lambert, previously at Marshall, and Ron English, previously at Florida. In his second stint on Purdue's staff, Mark Hagen was selected by Brohm and elevated to co-defensive coordinator.
- Lambert and English coach the linebacker and secondary groups, respectively, while Hagen returned to Purdue in 2021 to lead the defensive line. Brohm also added cornerbacks coach James Adams to his staff from Navy.

REMEMBERING LEROY

- Purdue icon, College Football Hall of Fame member and two-time consensus All-American Leroy Keyes passed away on April 15. In his honor, the 2021 Boilermakers will don a memorial sticker on their helmets for the entire season.
- A megastar Boilermaker from 1966-68, Keyes remains the only two-time consensus All-American for Purdue. He finished third and second in Heisman Trophy voting as a halfback his junior and senior seasons. Keyes, born Feb. 18, 1947, is survived by his wife, Monica, and children, Raymond, Jacqueline, Courtland and Colin.

REMEMBERING OTIS

- Purdue Football all-time great running back Otis Armstrong, a First Team All-American and 1972 Big Ten Conference Most Valuable Player, passed away on Oct. 13, at age 70.
- Following a standout collegiate career that would earn him entry into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2012, Armstrong was drafted ninth overall in the 1973 NFL Draft by the Denver Broncos.

YOU'RE TOO CLOSE, MAN

- Dating back to 2019, 11 of Purdue's last 20 games have been decided by seven points or less (including five of six games in 2020). The Boilermakers are 6-5 in those 11 contests.
