THREE POINT STANCE

THE GAME: The Idaho Vandals travel to Bloomington Indiana to face their second power five opponent in as many weeks. Idaho is 0-1 while Indiana is 1-0 on the year. It is the second meeting of the two teams after playing a year ago, a game Indiana won 56-14.

ABOUT IDAHO: The Vandals fell 24-17 in a hard-fought Battle of the Palouse, pushing Washington State to the final whistle before the Cougars sealed the game with an interception at the goal line in the final second. The energy is clearly different under first-year head coach Jason Eck and an entirely new Vandal staff. It was the first one-score game against a power-five team since 2011. Redshirt freshman Gevani McCoy played well in his just the second start of his career going 21-32 for 212 yard with a TD against a very good WSU defense.

ABOUT INDIANA: Indiana is 1-0 after a 23-20 win in a Big Ten game against Illinois in its season opener. Tom Allen leads the Hoosiers in his seventh season and he is 12-1 in non-conference games. Connor Bazalak had a solid performance at QB going 28-52 for 330 yards, a touchdown and an interception. Like Idaho, Indiana also forced three fumbles, but also added an interception on defense.

PICK SIX SEVEN

1. QB QUESTION ANSWERED: After a four-wide QB battle throughout the fall, **Gevani McCoy** earned the starting spot in the season opener against Washington State. The redshirt freshman played well against a very good WSU defense, throwing 21-32 for 212 yard with a TD. **J'Bore Gibbs** and **C.J. Jordan** are listed as backups on the week two depth chart. It was the second start ever for McCoy after starting one game against Montana last season and played in two other games Gibbs, a transfer from South Dakota State, played two seasons under head coach Jason Eck and offensive coordinator Luke Schleusner at SDSU. He played in 10 games and has passed for 1,071 yards and 10 touchdowns while running for four more. Jordan has played in five total games with 381 yards passing and a pair of TDs. True freshman Jack Layne also saw time with the first team offense this fall.

2. WELCOME FRESHMEN: True freshmen running back Anthony Woods and wide receiver Jordan Dwyer made their collegiate debuts to impressive results. Woods rushed nine times for 50 yards to lead all Idaho rushers. Dwyer caught three passes for 39 yards, including a 23-yard touchdown reception in the fourth quarter.

3. PRESEASONS HONORS: Preseason honors were slim for the Vandals. Senior linebacker **Fa'avae Fa'avae** was the lone Vandal to earn preseason All-Big Sky honors. The senior tallied 76 total tackles a season ago, including four TFLS and 1.5 sacks. He has 123 total tackles in his two seasons at Idaho.

4. IMPACT TRANSFERS: Five new transfers are listed on the Vandal defensive two-deep, two transfers are listed on the offensive list and one special teams player a and made an immediate. **Paul Moala**, a linebacker transfer from Notre Dame forced a fumble on the openine drive and **Juliano Falaniko**, a defensive end transfer from USC had four tackles and a sack. **Mathias Bertram** a safety from New Mexico had nine total tackles. Former NAIA All-American **Jason Hahlbeck**, a transfer from Morningside College, is expected to start at right tackle after missing the season opener with an injury. Junior college transfer **Ricardo Chavez** made an impact on special teams with his punting and a 28-yard made field goal.

5. RECEIVERS: The Vandals have depth in the wide receiver corps. **Terez Traynor** tallied 50 receptions last year for 737 yards and three touchdowns, including three games with over 100 yards receiving. **Hayden Hatten** played in three games a season ago before injury and had 215 yards and three touchdowns. He scored two against Indiana. He has over 1000 yards for his career. Jermaine Jackson is an emotional and vocal leader for the Idaho receivers. He played limited action in 2021 because of injury but looks to make an impact this season.

6. VETERAN RUNNING BACKS ROOM: Four Vandal running backs enter the season with considerable experience. Senior **Roshaun Johnson** has 1,011 career yards and 15 career touchdowns. He also holds the Idaho single-game touchdown record after scoring six times against Southern Utah last season. **Aundre Carter** has 849 career yards and 14 touchdowns. **Nick Romano** has 699 career yards and three touchdowns. **Eli Cummings** has 373 yards and a touchdown.

7. NEW BUT VETERAN STAFF: With the coaching staff change, head coach Jason Eck changed the entire staff. Among the 10 assistant coaches, seven have served as a coordinator in a college football setting and running backs coach **Thomas Ford** is a former DII head coach. **Stanley Franks Jr.** and **Matt Linehan** both had outstanding careers as players at the University of Idaho.

2022 CAPTAINS

At the spring game, head coach Jason Eck named seniors Fa'avae Fa'avae and Logan Floyd 2022 captains. Just last week, he added four more players to the 2022 captains group. Nate Degraw, Roshaun Johnson, Leo Tamba, Conner Whitney were all named captains on August 23rd.

VANDAL FOOTBALL A FAMILY AFFAIR

The 2022 Vandal football roster includes sets of brothers and two sets of twins. The McCormick brothers (Sean and Tommy) and the Hatten brothers (Hayden and Hogan) are twins. Ben and Mathias Bertram are not twins but are brothers who also appear on the two-deep.

NEW TRANSFERS

The Vandals added several transfers ahead of the fall season. J'bore Gibbs (South Dakota State), Paul Moala (Notre Dame), Mathias Bertram (New Mexico), Julian Falaniko (USC), Ben Bertram (New Mexico) and Jason Hahlbeck (Morningside) all joined the Vandals from four-year schools. Murvin Kenion III, Ricardo Chavez, and Tuiumi Aiono transferred from junior colleges.

IDAHO TO THE NFL

Two Idaho defensive graduates signed free agent deals. Former Buck Buchanan Award Finalist Tre Walker signed a deal with the Washington Commanders and defensive tackle Noah Elliss signed a deal with the Philadelphia Eagles.

POSITION CHANGE

There were two notable position changes for the Vandals this fall. Former Quarterback Zach Borisch moved to the Wide Receiver, but he will likely be utilized all over the field. Former Wide Receiver Michael Noil shifted to the defensive side of the ball to add depth to the cornerback position.

DOMESTIC FIELD ADVANTAGE

Idaho has notched a winning home record in each of the last four seasons and is 141-95-1 all time in the dome.

QUICK GAME NOTES

- Marcus Harris' scoop and score of 45 yards was the ninth-longest in Vandal history.

- It was the longest scoop and score since Lloyd Hightower's 49-yard fumble return TD against Idaho State in 2019.

- Jermaine Jackson caught six passes for a career-high 113 yards. His previous best was 48 yards against Eastern Washington on Oct. 16, 2021.

- The Vandals won the time of possession controlling the ball for over 36 minutes.

- The Vandals were 3-6 on fourth downs. Idaho forced three WSU fumbles, winning the turnover battle 3-2.

- Jordan Dwyer scored a touchdown in his first career game as a Vandal as a true freshman.

HEAD COACH JASON ECK



Jason Eck was named the 36th head coach in Idaho Vandal History on Dec. 18, 2021.

The 2019 America Football Coaches' Association FCS Assistant Coach of the Year spent the last six seasons at South Dakota State, where he helped lead SDSU to three semifinal appearances in four seasons and a national championship game appearance during the spring 2021 season. Eck has over two decades of experience as a college coach and returns to Moscow where he began his full-time coaching career.

In three years as the offensive coordinator at SDSU, Eck's teams have averaged 32.5 points per game, including 37.5 this season. The 2021 Jackrabbits are eighth in scoring offense, seventh in team passing efficiency and eighth in rushing offense with the FCS' leading rusher Pierre Strong leading the way.

In the 2021 spring season, Freshman quarterback Mark Gronowski was the runner-up for the Jerry Rice Award as the FCS freshman of the year before being injured on the first series of the National Championship game. The Jackrabbits fell 23-21 despite missing Gronowski.

The 2021 spring team showed off Eck's experience as an offensive line coach. The Jackrabbits were seventh in the FCS in rushing and fourth in the FCS for tackles for loss allowed despite playing some of the most physical defenses in the country in the MVFC. Sophomore offensive tackle Garret Greenfield was a near-consensus All-America selection. Sophomore guard Mason McCormick also received All-America recognition.

Eck served as the offensive line coach for the Jackrabbits from 2016-18. During his first season with the Jackrabbits, SDSU featured one of the most prolific offenses in the MVFC and the Football Championship Subdivision, posting averages of 33.2 points and 437.5 yards of total offense per game. In league contests, SDSU ranked second out of 10 teams in allowing only 11 total sacks and ranked first in five different offensive categories.

Before his time at SDSU, Eck was the offensive line coach and run-game coordinator at Montana State in 2015. The Bobcats were 18th in the FCS for rushing offense and 23rd in the FCS for sacks allowed. MSU was third in the FCS for scoring offense during his one season in Bozeman.

He was the Offensive Coordinator for the record-setting offense at Minnesota State, Mankato during back-to-back Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference championships in 2013 and 2014. He served as the offensive line coach in 2013 and added offensive coordinator duties in 2014 as the Mavericks advanced to the NCAA Division II championship game. The 2014 season saw Mankato finish 14th in Division II in rushing offense.

He also has served coaching stints at Winona State (2007-08), Ball State (2009-10), Hampton (2011) and Western Illinois (2012).

His first time as a Vandal came in 2004 when he coached the Vandal offensive line for three seasons. Eck spent two seasons under head coach Nick Holt and one under head coach Dennis Erickson.

A 1999 graduate of Wisconsin, Eck played on the Badgers' 1998 Big Ten championship team which went on to win the Rose Bowl.

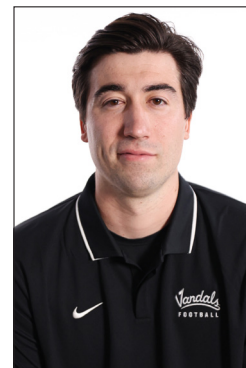

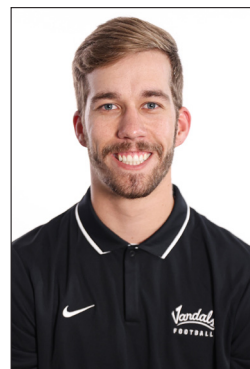

THE RETURN

THE KIBBIE DOME



The Kibbie-ASUI Activity Center, also called the "Kibbie Dome," is one of the most unique facilities in all of the NCAA.

The Kibbie Dome has been the home of Vandal athletics since 1975, when the barrel-arch roof was completed. In 1976, the building earned the award for America's Outstanding Structural Engineering Achievement.

It took nearly seven years to complete the 14-story-tall structure, which is tall enough that Idaho's Theophilus Tower dormitory would fit inside. Construction began in 1969 on the site of the former Neale Stadium, which had been partially destroyed by fire. The field and stands were completed in 1971, but it took four more years to finish the unique roof. The east end addition, which includes the athletic department offices, locker rooms, training rooms and a weight room, was completed in 1982.

In 2004, the facility began its next phase of improvement, as enhanced academic and athletic support facilities were added for student-athletes. The Norm and Becky Iverson Speed and Strength Center was added to more than double the size of the previous weight room to 7,000 square feet. Locker rooms were also expanded to more than 14,000 square feet.

Team meeting rooms, two student-athlete computer labs and study rooms and expanded academic support areas have also been added. In 2010, the athletic training and equipment rooms were expanded and upgraded to nearly double their respective work areas.

In 2010 and 2011, the old plywood end walls were replaced with state-of-the-art KalWall translucent panels as part of a major renovation to bring the building up to code. In conjunction with the end-wall replacement and fire-safety measures, the Litehouse Center, Bud and June Ford Club and expanded premium seating, suites and loge boxes were added and the Bob Curtis Press Box was completely rebuilt on the North side of the facility. Those improvements were privately funded.

The Kibbie Dome serves as both a training and competition facility for many of Idaho's 16 varsity athletic teams, including football, basketball, track & field, tennis and starting in 2017 soccer. The facility has a capacity of more than 16,000. When the fans get excited, the Kibbie Dome crowd noise can be deafening and intimidating to opposing teams.

Beneath the football field, which is rolled up and stored at season's end, is a premier indoor track & field facility, as well as a full indoor tennis facility. The Cowan Spectrum, where Idaho men's and women's basketball play their home games, is also a part of the Kibbie Dome floor. With 93,000 square feet of floor, there is plenty of room for each team to practice at the same time.

Vandal track & field athletes can practice year-round in the facility. The track is a 290-meter flat circular with eight lanes in the straightaway. It also has two long jump pits, two pole vault pits and two throwing circles. The spacious floor area also gives the Kibbie Dome enough space to host indoor discus and javelin competitions, a boast few other indoor facilities in the nation can make.

The Idaho men's and women's tennis programs use the facility to train and compete during the winter and in times of inclement weather conditions. The floor can be cleared for action on up to nine courts at once.

The Kibbie Dome is for more than just Vandal Athletics, too. The facility has been used to host a multitude of different events, including Idaho high school football playoffs, concerts, student activities, intramural sports, community events and graduations. The facility is also used by students and staff as a workout venue.

The internationally-renowned Lionel Hampton International Jazz Festival also calls the Kibbie Dome its home. One of the banner accomplishments of the University of Idaho, the festival was recently awarded the National Medal of Arts, the nation's most prestigious arts honor. The festival dates back to 1967 and during its history, it has featured some of the best jazz musicians to ever play, including Ella Fitzgerald, Gerry Mulligan, Dizzy Gillespie, Dianne Reeves, Stan Getz, Carmen McRae, Diana Krall, Wynton Marsalis and Sarah Vaughan and of course, Lionel Hampton and his New York Big Band.

Every year, thousands of high-school, middle-school and elementary-school students from hundreds of schools all around the United States and Canada make the pilgrimage to Moscow to take part in adjudicated performances, workshops and concerts.
