GAME NOTES

* Western Illinois University hits the road this weekend, playing under the Friday Night Lights at Indiana. The game will be televised on Big Ten Network at 6 p.m.

* This is the first all-time meeting between the two programs. Western Illinois has never defeated a Big 10 program. It's last win over an FBS program was a 52-10 win over Coastal Carolina on Sept. 23, 2017.

* Western Illinois opened the season last week, falling at Northern Illinois, 54-15. The Leathernecks trailed 6-3 after the first period before NIU broke open the game with a 28-0 advantage in the second quarter.

* Antonio Chadha's two field goals were the most by a Western Illinois kicker since Owen Valek made a pair against Lindenwood last season ... Mayo Bola's blocked extra point and return for score by Fredrik Greenhoward was the fourth time in Leatherneck history the football program has accomplished the feat. The last time it occurred was November 8, 2014 when Kevin Kintzel recorded the block and Martinez Davis had the return ... Bola's blocked extra the point was the first by a Leatherneck since Brian Bruce's block last season vs. Southern Utah ... Western Illinois' offense did not commit a turnover, the first time for the Leathernecks since the game vs. Lindenwood last season ... Willie Jones' 13 tackles last weekend at Northern Illinois were a new career high for the defensive back.

* WIU is on the road next weekend, taking on in-state, and former MVFC rival, Illinois State. The Leathernecks then take their bye week before hosting McKendree in the home opener on September 28. WIU then begins its inaugural season in the Big South-OVC Football Association the following weekend at Charleston Southern.

ONE OF A KIND

Western Illinois holds the distinction of being the only non-military institution to officially have its nickname derived from a branch of the military service. The school began use of the Marine Corps' official nickname, "The Fighting Leathernecks", in 1927 when then-athletic director and head baseball, basketball and football coach Ray "Rock" Hanson was granted permission by the U.S. Navy, based on his status as a Marine hero, to use the nickname.

HEAD COACH JOE DAVIS



On December 10, 2023 Western Illinois Athletic Director Paul A. Bubbs announced Joe Davis as the new Leatherneck head football coach.

Davis, who most recently served as quarterbacks coach/offensive coordinator at Eastern Illinois, becomes the 32nd coach in the WIU program's 120-year history.

"I am extremely excited and happy to welcome Joe Davis to the Leathernecks," Bubbs said. "Joe clearly met the expectations that we have for our head coach. He has the experience in FCS football, has developed numerous outstanding FCS players, and has been part of teams that won championships. I believe his teams will play an exciting offensive style of football with an aggressive defense that will return Leatherneck football to a competitive and championship caliber program."

Davis, who has been at Eastern Illinois since 2022, led the Panthers to their first eight-win season since 2013. EIU also reached a No. 24

ranking in the FCS American Football Coaches Association Poll.

This past season, the Panther offense ranked third in the Big South/Ohio Valley Alliance, the conference Western Illinois will join next fall.

In his coaching career, which began in 2003, Davis has produced nine seasons in which his quarterback has passed for over 3,000 yards and 30 touchdowns, and four All-American quarterbacks, three of which were invited to National Football League camps, and he helped lead a trio of programs to NCAA postseason berths.

Prior to his time at Eastern Illinois, Davis served as associate head coach/offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at the University of Albany from 2018-2021.

As offensive coordinator at Albany, Davis' unit advanced to the second round of the 2019 playoffs, while earning a No. 15 national ranking. The offense broke 21 school records while improving from the worst-ranked offense in the Colonial Athletic Association to the third best. Davis' quarterback also broke the school passing records while leading the country in passing touchdowns.

In the collegiate ranks, Davis has coached at Fordham, Northern Iowa, Shippensburg, Wheaton, North Park and Wayne State.

He also coached and played professionally for the Vienna Rangers American Football Club in Vienna, Austria, as well as played in the Arena Football League for three seasons.

"One of the reasons I was really attracted to this opportunity, there has been a tradition of excellence in the football program over the years," Davis said. "There have been excellent players, excellent teams, excellent coaches and that's something that attracted me to this opportunity and being the coach at Western Illinois."
