NOTABLES

• The Indiana Men's Basketball team (6-0, 0-0 B1G) is off to a 6-0 start for the first time since the 2022-23 season following a 86-69 win over Kansas State on Tuesday (Nov. 25) at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall.

• IU never trailed in the game and led for 39:47 in the contest. The two teams were tied for the first 13 seconds before an 8-0 run opened up the IU scoring on Tuesday.

• The Hoosiers made 10 3-point field goals in Tuesday's win. It's the fourth time in six games this season that IU has connected on double-digit 3-point field goals.

• IU has now won 36-straight non-conference games at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall, dating back to a defeat to Arkansas on Dec. 29, 2019.

• Head coach Darian DeVries' defense played hard for all 40 minutes on Tuesday. IU held Kansas State to a season low in points (69). The Wildcats came into the game averaging 92.4 points per game.

• IU has forced double-digit turnovers in five of six games this season. IU's opponents have turned the ball over nine times or more in all six contests. Kansas State's 19 turnovers are the most by an IU opponent since Dec. 20, 2022 (Elon - 19).

• Senior forward **Reed Bailey** led the Hoosiers with 21 points. He added four rebounds and two assists while shooting 13-of-15 from the free throw line.

• Bailey's 13 made free throws are the most in a single game since All-American forward Trayce Jackson-Davis connected on 14 in a win over North Alabama (Nov. 12, 2019).

• Sixth-year senior guard **Tayton Conerway** scored 19 points on the evening, his third game this season in double figures. He added four rebounds, two assists and three steals.

• Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** provided 14 points. All four of his made field goals were from beyond the arc. He was a team best +26 on the evening. He also had four rebounds.

• Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** provided 12 points in reserve, the second time in his young career he's scored in double figures. He added five rebounds in 21 minutes.

• Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** scored nine points while grabbing six rebounds and dishing out five assists.

• Senior forward **Sam Alexis** worked through foul trouble to provide three points, two rebounds, a block and an assist.

• Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** was all over the statsheet with seven points, six rebounds, two steals and three assists.

• Junior guard **Nick Dorn** scored one point and grabbed a rebound. He also had a block in 11 minutes of run.

• Junior guard **Jasai Miles** played two minutes off the bench.

• Up Next: IU closes out Thanksgiving week with a visit from Bethune-Cookman on Saturday (Nov. 29) afternoon at Noon. Big Ten Network will carry the contest at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall.
