NOTABLES

- The Indiana Men's Basketball team (8-2, 1-1 B1G) picked up its first Big Ten win of the season with a dominant 113-72 victory over Penn State on Tuesday (Dec. 9) evening at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall.
- The Hoosiers connected on 17 3-point baskets on Tuesday night. It's the seventh time this season that the team has hit double-digit 3-point field goals in the same game.
- IU's 17 made 3-point field goals are the most in a single game since connecting on 19 in a win over Illinois in 2016. It's just the fifth time in program history that IU has made 17-or-more baskets from beyond the arc.
- IU has forced 10-or-more turnovers in seven-consecutive games after Penn State turned the rock over on 14 occasions in Tuesday's contest.
- This is IU's first time beating a Big Ten opponent by 40-or-more points since a 48-point win over Penn State on Jan. 9, 1993. IU's 113 points are the most scored in a Big Ten contest since putting up 118 in a win over Iowa on February 17, 1990.
- IU led by 32 points (58-26) at the halftime break. It is the first time IU has taken a lead of 30-or-more points into the locker room during a Big Ten game since Jan. 10, 2016 (48-18 - vs. Ohio State).
- This is the fourth time since 1996-97 that IU has scored 100+ points in a Big Ten game. It is the first time since it did so in regulation since Jan. 19, 2016 against Illinois.
- IU has scored at least 100 points in four wins this season. It's the 12th year in program history that IU has provided at least four games of 100-or-more points.
- The Hoosiers tied the program's single-game assist record in a Big Ten contest with 30 helpers against Penn State. It is tied for the most in a single game against any division one team in IU history.
- Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** scored a career high 44 points in one of the best performances in program history. He added four rebounds and four assists in just 24 minutes of action.
- Wilkerson scored 20 points in the first half of Tuesday's win and 24 in the second half. He's the second player this season to score at least 20 points in a half this season (DeVries - 24 vs. Marquette).
- The veteran guard broke a single-game program record with 10 made 3-point field goals. He also broke the Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall scoring record with 44 total points.
- Wilkerson's 44 points are tied for eighth most in a single game in program history. He's the first IU player to score 40+ points in a Big Ten game since Alan Henderson (41 at Michigan State, March 9, 1994).
- Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** scored 12 points on 5-of-10 shooting in the win. It's his eighth time scoring in double figures this year. He's connected on at least multiple 3-point field goals in four-straight contests.
- Junior guard **Nick Dorn** provided 13 points in a season-high 24 minutes off the bench. He's scored in double figures in consecutive games for the first time this season.



NOTABLES

- Senior forward **Reed Bailey** scored 18 points in the win without missing a shot from the field. He also connected on all six free-throw attempts. He added five rebounds.
- Sixth-year senior guard **Tayton Conerway** was one of five players in double figures. He connected on 7-of-9 shots from the floor. He added seven assists in the win, his third game of the year with seven-or-more assists.
- Senior forward **Sam Alexis** dished out three assists and pulled down two rebounds.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** scored four points and grabbed eight rebounds.
- Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** provided two points and a season-high eight assists.
- Freshman guard **Aleksa Ristic** knocked down a 3-point field goal for his first career points.
- Up Next: IU heads back on the road to renew its rivalry with Kentucky on Saturday (Dec. 13) at 7:30 p.m. on ESPN. It's the first time the two teams will play in the regular season since 2011.
