## NOTABLES

- The Indiana Men's Basketball team (9-3, 1-1 B1G) returned to winning ways on Saturday (Dec. 20) afternoon with a 78-58 win at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. The Hoosiers are 8-0 in home games this season.
- IU connected on 14 3-point field goals in the first half and hit 15 in total. It's the eighth time IU has hit at least 10 3-point field goals in a game this year and the fourth it has gone for
- The Hoosiers attempted a single-game program record 46 3-point field goals. Three different players took at least 10 attempts from beyond the arc.
- Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** led the team with 21 points. He's scored in double figures in eight-straight games and 11 of 12 games overall this season. It's the 29th game of his career with at least 20 points.
- He hit five 3-point baskets in the win on Saturday. It's the sixth time this season that he's connected on at least four 3-point field goals in a game.
- Senior forward **Reed Bailey** put up 17 points on 6-of-9 shooting from the floor. He added a season-high eight rebounds.
- Junior guard **Nick Dorn** scored 15 points on 5-of-11 shooting from beyond the arc. Every shot he attempted was from 3-point range. It's the second time this season that he's hit at least five baskets from beyond the arc.
- Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** scored eight points. He provided five rebounds and three assists and was a team-high +29 from the floor.
- · Sixth-year senior guard **Tayton Conerway** added five points. He offered up seven rebounds and five assists. In the win, Conerway recorded his 1,000th-career point. He hit the threshold in just three seasons of Division I basketball.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** had six points and grabbed five rebounds.
- Senior forward **Sam Alexis** put up two points and four rebounds.
- Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** led the team with seven assists. He had four points and two rebounds in the win.
- Junior guard **Jasai Miles** saw seven minutes of action. He had three rebounds.
- Freshman guard **Aleksa Ristic** appeared for two minutes off the bench.
- Up Next: IU will be back in action on Monday (Dec. 22) against Siena at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall to wrap up the pre-Christmas slate.
