NOTABLES

- The Indiana Men's Basketball team (11-3, 2-1 B1G) returned to Big Ten play with a 90-80 win over Washington on Sunday (Jan. 4) evening at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. The Hoosiers are now 10-0 at home this season.
- IU connected on 12 3-point field goals in the victory. It's the ninth time this year that the Hoosiers have made at least 10 baskets from beyond the arc. Five different players knocked down a basket from long range in the win.
- IU scored 52 points in the first half. It's the 10th time this season that the Hoosiers have scored at least 50 points in a given half. It is the seventh time the team has done so in a first half (second time in a Big Ten game).
- The Hoosiers had just four turnovers in the victory. It's the fewest number of turnovers by an IU team since a win over Ohio State (4) on Jan. 6, 2024.
- Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** scored 18 of his 22 points in the second half while playing 39 of 40 minutes in the game. He added four rebounds and three assists.
- Wilkerson has connected on multiple 3-point field goals in eight-straight contests. He's the first IU player to score 20+ points in three-straight games since Trayce Jackson-Davis (6 - Feb. 28-March 19, 2023).
- Sixth-year senior guard **Tayton Conerway** provided 20 points in the win. He missed just one shot attempt the entire evening. He shot 6-of-7 from the floor, 4-of-4 from beyond the arc and 4-of-4 from the charity stripe.
- He produced his second 20-point effort of the season and his first in a Big Ten game. It was the 10th 20-point game of his career. He's the fourth player on IU's roster to score 20-plus points in at least 10 career games.
- Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** scored a season-high 12 points in the win over Washington. He finished with nine assists, just one shy of a double-double.
- He reached double figures for the first time this season and just the 18th time in his career. He's the eighth different IU player to score double-digit points this year.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** scored all 10 of his points in the second half. He was a team-best +17 from the floor in just 15 minutes off the bench.
- He scored in double figures for the first time since November 29th. It's the first time he has scored 10+ points in a Big Ten game in his young career.
- Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** put up six points on Sunday evening. He pulled down four rebounds in 31 minutes of run.
- Junior guard **Nick Dorn** added valuable time off the bench with eight points and two rebounds.
- Senior forward **Sam Alexis** scored four points and grabbed six rebounds.
- Senior forward **Reed Bailey** added eight points and three rebounds.
- Up Next: IU heads on the road for the first time in the calendar year. The Hoosiers will play Maryland on Wednesday (Jan. 7) in College Park. Tip is set for 6:30 p.m. on BTN.
