## NOTABLES

- The Indiana Men's Basketball team (12-3, 3-1 B1G) used a big second half to pick up its first true road win of the season. IU outscored Maryland by 13 points after the break in the 84-66 win on Wednesday evening.
- The 18-point margin of victory is the highest of any IU win in College Park in program history. It's the best by an IU team in the series since winning by 18 in Bloomington on March 6, 2016.
- IU connected on eight 3-point field goals in the victory. It's the 13th time this year that the Hoosiers have made at least eight baskets from beyond the arc.
- The Hoosiers stifled Maryland's offense on Wednesday evening. The Terrapins shot just 19.2 percent from beyond the arc. It's the 12th time this season that an IU opponent has scored fewer than 75 points in a game.
- IU made 22 free throws in the win over Maryland. It is the fifth time the team has connected on at least 20 attempts from the charity stripe. The Hoosiers shot 84.6 percent on the night.
- Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** scored 18 of his 24 points in the second half while playing 39 of 40 minutes in the game. He was +21 in his time on the court.
- Wilkerson has connected on multiple 3-point field goals in nine-straight contests. He's the first IU player to score 20+ points in four-straight games since Trayce Jackson-Davis (6 - Feb. 28-March 19, 2023).
- In Sunday's win over Washington, Wilkerson went for 18 second half points. To follow that up, the veteran guard added an additional 18 points after the break against Maryland.
- Sixth-year senior guard **Tayton Conerway** scored 19 points on 6-of-12 shooting from the floor. He came within shouting distance of a double-double with eight rebounds. He added three assists in the win.
- Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** scored a season-high 16 points in the win over Washington. He went 5-of-7 from the floor. Enright added four rebounds and three assists. He connected on multiple 3-point field goals for just the second time this season.
- He has scored 10-or-more points in consecutive games for the first time in an IU uniform and for the first time overall since December of 2024 while at Depaul.
- Senior forward **Reed Bailey** scored 15 points on Wednesday night. It's the sixth time this season that he's scored in double figures.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** added three points and four rebounds.
- Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** provided five points, two rebounds and two assists.
- Junior guard **Nick Dorn** put up three rebounds in just 12 minutes.
- Senior forward **Sam Alexis** started his sixth-straight game and scored two points.
- Up Next: IU will meet top-10 ranked Nebraska on Saturday (Jan. 10) at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. Tipoff is set for Noon on Big Ten Network.
