NOTABLES

- The Indiana Men's Basketball team (12-4, 3-2 B1G) saw a late lead slip away in a 83-77 loss to No. 10/11 Nebraska on Saturday (Jan. 10) afternoon at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. IU was outscored by 15 points in the second half.
- IU connected on 11 3-point field goals in the victory. It's the 10th time in 11 home games that the Hoosiers have hit at least nine 3-point baskets.
- The Hoosiers converted on 82.6% of free throws on Saturday. It's the fifth-straight game that IU has made at least 80% of its shots from the charity stripe.
- Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** scored a game-high 32 points. He was a perfect 9-of-9 from the charity stripe. He has scored in double figures in all but one contest this season. The veteran guard recorded four assists and four rebounds as well.
- With his second 30-point effort of the season, he's the first Big Ten player this year with multiple 30-point outings against conference opponents (44 - vs. Penn State, 32 vs. Nebraska).
- Wilkerson has connected on multiple 3-point field goals in 10-straight contests. He's hit four-or-more shots from beyond the arc in six different games this year.
- Since the 2006-07 season, Wilkerson is one of three IU players to score 20-or-more in at least five straight games (Trayce Jackson-Davis (6) - 2022-23, Eric Gordon (7) - 2007-08).
- Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** provided 17 points with six rebounds in 29 minutes of action. It's the second time this season he's scored 10+ points in a Big Ten contest.
- Senior forward **Reed Bailey** was the third IU player in double figures with 10 points. He finished with nine rebounds, one shy of his first double-double of the year. He has scored 10+ points in consecutive games for the first time this season.
- Junior guard **Nick Dorn** provided six points, scoring all of his points on 3-point field goals.
- Sixth-year senior guard **Tayton Conerway** added three points, five rebounds and five assists.
- Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** tallied four points, two assists and two rebounds.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** put up three points and one rebound.
- Senior forward **Sam Alexis** went for two points, a rebound and an assist.
- Up Next: IU will head up to East Lansing on Tuesday (Jan. 13) evening to face nationally-ranked Michigan State. Tip is set for 7 p.m. on Peacock.
