NOTABLES

- The Indiana Men's Basketball team (13-7, 4-5 B1G) returned to winning ways with a commanding 82-59 win on Friday (Jan. 23) evening at Jersey Mike's Arena in Piscataway. IU led for 39:17 of the game and never trailed in the win. Friday's win was the first road win in Piscataway since Feb. 5, 2018.
- The Hoosiers hit 15 3-point field goals on the night, including eight in the first half. It's the 13th time this season that IU has reached double digits in the category. It's IU's most made 3-point field goals in a true road contest since Jan. 8, 2012 (16) against Penn State.
- For the first time since Jan. 6, 2018, the Hoosiers had three different players score at least 20 points in a Big Ten game. Between then and Friday evening, it had happened once more in a triple overtime loss at Syracuse (Nov. 30, 2021).
- IU had just five turnovers in the victory, one of those coming on a shot clock violation while declining to shoot with a 23-point lead. It's just the third time since at least 1997 with five-or-fewer turnovers in a true road game. IU last turned the ball over fewer than six times in a road game on Feb. 25, 2015 (4 - at Northwestern).
- Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** torched the nets with 27 points on 11-of-17 shooting from the floor. It is the ninth time this season that he's recorded 20 points. He connected on five 3-point field goals for the third time in five games.
- Junior guard **Nick Dorn** provided 23 points on Friday night, the first 20-point game of his IU career. He hit six 3-point field goals, the third time in his collegiate career that he's knocked down six makes from beyond the arc.
- Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** had a fantastic all-around night. He had 22 points, 10 rebounds and six assists. It was the 11th double-double of his career and the first in a Big Ten game during his time at IU. DeVries started the 125th game of his college career on Friday evening. He's the 10th active player in Division I college basketball to reach that mark.
- He became the seventh IU player over the last 30 seasons to have a 20-10-5 game. He's the first to do it since Oumar Ballo on Feb. 26, 2025 against Penn State.
- He's the second player in that span to do so while shooting zero free throws and knocking down at least four 3-point field goals (Robert Vaden vs. Michigan State - Feb. 26, 2006).
- Senior forward **Sam Alexis** scored four points, blocked six shots and grabbed 10 rebounds. He's the eighth IU player since 1997 with at least six blocks in a game.
- He's the first Hoosier to have at least six blocks and 10 rebounds in a Big Ten game since Trayce Jackson-Davis on Jan. 25, 2023 (21 rebounds, 6 blocks).
- Sixth-year senior guard **Tayton Conerway** scored six points off the bench in the victory.
- Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** grabbed four rebounds and had two assists.
- Senior forward **Reed Bailey** played 10 minutes and had one rebound.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** played four minutes in reserve.
- Junior guard **Jasai Miles** provided 11 minutes off the bench.
- Up Next: IU comes back to Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall for an in-state rivalry matchup against Purdue next Tuesday (Jan. 27). Tip is set for 9 p.m. on Peacock.
