NOTABLES

- The Indiana Men's Basketball team (14-7, 5-5 B1G) picked up its first ranked win of the season on Tuesday (Jan. 27) evening with a 72-67 win over #12/12 Purdue at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall.
- IU is now 18-8 all-time when a ranked Purdue team comes to Bloomington. The Hoosiers have beaten the Boilermakers in four of the last five contests when the visitors are ranked. Head coach **Darian DeVries** picked up his first ranked victory at IU.
- The Hoosiers hit 12 3-point field goals on the night, including eight in the first half. It's the 14th time this season that IU has reached double digits in the category. IU is averaging 11.0 made 3-point field goals per game in Big Ten play.
- IU led for over 30 minutes in Tuesday's ballgame. The Hoosiers ended the first half on a 19-6 run and led for the entire 20-minute second half. Purdue closed the deficit to two (65-63) with 1:28 to go before a late 3-point field goal from redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** iced the game.
- Enright contributed eight points and eight assists in the win. He played the full 40 minutes and limited Purdue's All-American point guard, Braden Smith, to just 14 points. Smith also committed four of Purdue's 10 turnovers.
- Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** led the Hoosiers in scoring for the second-straight game. He scored 19 points while grabbing seven rebounds and dished out three assists.
- He's scored in double figures in all but three games this year and has knocked down multiple 3-point field goals in 16 of IU's contests this season.
- Junior guard **Nick Dorn** provided 18 points in the victory on 6-of-11 shooting from the floor. He connected on four made 3-point field goals in the win.
- He's hit multiple 3-point field goals in three-straight games. Dorn has scored in double figures in three-straight games. He's averaging 18.3 points per game since the start of the Michigan game on January 20th.
- Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** added nine points, 10 rebounds and three assists in the victory. DeVries has recorded double-digit rebounds in consecutive games for the first time in his career.
- Senior forward **Sam Alexis** scored two points and grabbed one rebound.
- Senior forward **Reed Bailey** scored nine points and grabbed two rebounds. He had one assist as well.
- Junior guard **Jasai Miles** scored five points and grabbed two rebounds. He was +10 in his 15 minutes of action on Tuesday.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** scored two points in three minutes of run off the bench.
- Up Next: IU makes the swing out west to face the Los Angeles schools beginning on Saturday (Jan. 31). The Hoosiers start the trip against UCLA at historic Pauley Pavilion at 5 p.m. ET on Peacock.
