NOTABLES

• The Indiana Men's Basketball team (15-7, 6-5 B1G) won its third-straight game on Saturday (Jan. 31) evening with a 98-97 win in double overtime over UCLA at Pauley Pavilion. It's IU first win in double overtime since Feb. 10, 2021 (at Northwestern).

• IU had 22 assists on 28 made field goals on Saturday. The Hoosiers have won all seven contests this year where they've had at least 20 helpers.

• Head coach Darian DeVries' ballclub converted on 31-of-38 free throw attempts in the win. The 31 makes from the charity stripe are the most in a game since Nov. 12, 2019 (37 - vs. North Alabama).

• The Hoosiers hit 11 3-point field goals in the win. It's the 15th time this season they have connected on at least 10 made baskets from beyond the arc. In those 15 games, IU is 11-4.

• After hitting 11 3-point field goals against UCLA, the Hoosiers have recorded double-digit makes from beyond the arc in four-straight games. It's the first four-game stretch of such in league play since the 2002-03 season.

• Junior guard **Nick Dorn** provided a team-high 26 points in the victory on 6-of-15 shooting from beyond the arc. It's his second game with at least 20 points in the last three contests.

• He's hit at least four 3-point field goals in each of the last four games. In his three starts this season, Dorn is averaging 22.3 points per game. Today's win was his 50th career start.

• Dorn is the first IU player with at least 25 points and six made 3-point field goals in a road Big Ten contest since Robert Johnson in 2018 at Iowa (29 points, nine 3-points makes).

• He is the first IU player to hit at least six 3-point field goals in multiple Big Ten games in the same season since Yogi Ferrell in the 2014-15 campaign (3).

• Senior forward **Reed Bailey** provided 24 points, six rebounds and five assists. He converted on 12-of-13 attempts from the free throw line.

• Bailey is the first IU player to score at least 20 points off the bench since Malik Reneau at Washington last season (22 - March 1, 2025). It's the most bench points by an IU player since Devonte Green against Ohio State (26 - March 14, 2019).

• For IU, it's the first time a player has had a 20-5-5 game off bench since at least 1996-97. Bailey played 28 minutes before fouling out in overtime.

• Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** scored 24 points and grabbed eight rebounds. He scored 10 of his points in the overtime periods. Today was his 10th 20-point game of the year.

• He's scored in double figures in all but three games this year and has knocked down multiple 3-point field goals in 17 of IU's contests this season.

• Saturday's win was the first time that three different players (Dorn - 26, Wilkerson - 24, Bailey - 24) scored at least 24 points in a game since Feb. 1, 2017 vs. Penn State (Bryant - 31, Johnson - 27, Newkirk - 27).

• Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** scored nine points, dished out seven assists and had 10 rebounds. He's just the second IU player (Trayce Jackson-Davis, 3) with a 9-10-7 game in Big Ten action since 1996-97. He's had 10 rebounds in three-straight games.

• Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** scored five points and dished out seven assists. It was his seventh game of the season with at least seven helpers. He fouled out after playing 39 minutes.



NOTABLES

- Senior forward **Sam Alexis** scored seven points and grabbed three rebounds.
- Junior guard **Jasai Miles** picked up two rebounds in nine minutes.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** scored three points including the game-winning free throw in double overtime.
- Up Next: IU completes its trip out west with a matchup against USC at the Galen Center on Tuesday (Feb. 3) evening. Tip is set for 10 p.m. ET on Peacock.
