NOTABLES

• The Indiana Men's Basketball team (16-8, 7-6 B1G) picked up a 78-77 overtime victory over Wisconsin on Saturday (Feb. 7) afternoon at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. IU has won four consecutive overtime contests dating back to 2023.

• IU's win on Saturday gives it three-straight wins over Wisconsin in Bloomington. The Hoosiers are now 12-2 on their home court this year. It's IU's first win over a power conference opponent this season when making five-or-fewer 3-point field goals.

• The Hoosiers had just eight turnovers in the overtime win. It's the 10th time this season that IU has given the ball away on fewer than 10 occasions. The Hoosiers are turning the ball over just 8.4 times per game over the last five contests.

• Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** produced a team-high 25 points. He's scored 20 points in three-straight games and on 12 total occasions this year. He's averaging 25.6 points per game over his past five outings.

• Wilkerson scored all six of IU's points in overtime. In extra periods this year, the veteran guard has provided 16 of the Hoosiers' 28 points.

• Senior forward **Sam Alexis** scored a season-best 19 points on 9-for-10 shooting from the floor. He added seven rebounds and five blocks.

• Alexis scored in double figures for the first since a contest on January 20th at Michigan. It's his eighth game this season with 10+ points - his fourth in Big Ten play. The 19 points were his most in a game since joining the program.

• He's one of two IU players (Kel'el Ware) since 1996-97 to score at least 19 points, shoot above 90% from the floor, grab seven rebounds and block five shots in a game. Both players did it in wins over Wisconsin in Bloomington.

• Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** went for 11 points, six assists and four rebounds in the win. He had zero turnovers in 39 minutes of action.

• Enright reached double-digit scoring for just the third time this season. It was his 11th game of the year with five-or-more assists.

• Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** played the full 45 minutes. He added 16 points and eight rebounds. He was good on 3-of-7 attempts from beyond the arc.

• After a brief three-game hiatus, DeVries returned to double-digit scoring against the Badgers. It's his fifth league contest this year with 10-or-more points.

• Junior guard **Jasai Miles** scored four points off the bench. He had five rebounds and a block in 25 minutes of run.

• Senior forward **Reed Bailey** added one point and one rebound.

• Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** went for two points and two rebounds.

• Junior guard **Nick Dorn** played 27 minutes and grabbed two rebounds.

• Up Next: A quick turnaround awaits IU this weekend. The Hoosiers will host Oregon at 8:30 p.m. ET on Monday (Feb. 9) on FS1 to complete the season series against the West Coast schools.
