NOTABLES

• The Indiana Men's Basketball team (17-8, 8-6 B1G) won its second-straight game with a 92-74 victory over Oregon on Monday (Feb. 9) evening at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. The Hoosiers finished the regular season at 3-1 against the west coast schools.

• IU knocked down 11 3-point field goals in the win. It's the 17th time this season and the seventh time in the last eight outings that the Hoosiers have connected on double-digit makes from beyond the arc.

• Head coach Darian DeVries' ballclub dished out 22 assists and had just nine turnovers. It's the fourth time this season that IU has had 20+ assists and fewer than 10 giveaways in the same contest. It's the first time doing so in a Big Ten game since Jan. 26, 2020 (vs. Maryland).

• The Hoosiers shot 81.8% from the floor (18-22) in the second half of the win over Oregon. It's the first time since Nov. 16, 2015 (Austin Peay) that IU has shot at least 80.0% from the field in a single half.

• Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** produced a team-high 41 points in the win. He's scored 20 points in four-straight games and on 13 total occasions this year. Wilkerson is averaging 33 points per game in February.

• Wilkerson is the first player since James Blackmon Jr. (2016-17) to hit at least 80 3-point field goals in a season. He's just the seventh Hoosiers (on eight occasions) to make 80-or-more shots from beyond the arc in a year.

• The veteran guard is one of four IU players (Steve Alford, Jay Edwards and Yogi Ferrell) to make 50-or-more 3-point field goals during a Big Ten season. Wilkerson needs four to break that all-time program record.

• He's the first IU player since at least 1996-97 with four separate 30-plus point efforts in a single Big Ten season. He has produced three of the 10 highest-scoring regular season Big Ten efforts by an IU player in that same timeframe.

• He became the fifth player in program history (Jimmy Rayl, Steve Downing, Don Schlundt and George McGinnis) to record multiple 40-point games in his career. He's the first Big Ten player since at least 1996-97 with multiple 40-point efforts in conference play during the same year.

• Senior forward **Sam Alexis** scored 16 points on 8-for-8 shooting. He grabbed five rebounds and provided two assists. He has made 24 of his last 25 field goal attempts dating back to a win over Purdue (Jan. 27).

• Alexis has scored in double figures in four of his last eight contests. It is the fourth time this year he's had back-to-back 10+ point efforts.

• Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** provided 15 points on 5-for-10 shooting. He dished out seven assists and grabbed three rebounds. He has had 12 games with 15-or-more points this year.

• Junior guard **Nick Dorn** was the fourth player in double-figure scoring. He scored 11 points and had three rebounds and two assists. It's his 11th game with 10-or-more points this year.

• Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** provided five points, six rebounds and eight assists. Over his last five games, he has 37 assists to just seven turnovers.

- Junior guard **Jasai Miles** recorded three rebounds in nine minutes of action.
- Sixth-year senior guard **Tayton Conerway** scored a point and had a rebound in his return to the floor.
- Senior forward **Reed Bailey** offered up three points.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** played six minutes.
- Freshman guard **Aleksa Ristic** appeared off the bench.
