NOTABLES

- The Indiana Men's Basketball team (17-11, 8-9 BIG) dropped a 72-68 contest to Northwestern on Tuesday (Feb. 24) evening at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. It is the third-straight loss for IU.
• IU converted on 10 made 3-point field goals. The Hoosiers have made double-digit baskets from beyond the arc on 18 occasions this year.
• Fifth-year senior guard Lamar Wilkerson scored 18 points with four makes from beyond the arc. He grabbed five rebounds and three assists.
• His four made 3-point field goals moved him into second place (92) in a single season in program history. He passed James Blackmon Jr. (91 - 2016-17) and trails just Steve Alford (107 - 1986-87) in IU history.
• Senior forward Sam Alexis added 13 points on 6-for-7 shooting from the floor. He compiled four rebounds and three assists.
• Alexis returned to double-figure scoring in the win over Northwestern. Over the last five games, the big man is averaging 12.8 points per game. He's scored at least 10 points in seven conference outings this year.
• Sixth-year senior guard Tayton Conerway put up 14 points off the bench while going a perfect 6-for-6 from the floor. He was a team-high +15 in just 19 minutes of run.
• After missing some time due to injury, Conerway has now scored in double figures in consecutive games for the first time since early January.
• Redshirt senior forward Tucker DeVries totaled 11 points on the night. He recorded two rebounds and an assist. He has scored in double figures in five-straight games for the first time since the opening five games of the year.
• Redshirt senior guard Conor Enright dished out five assists. It's the 14th game this year where the veteran has provided at least five assists.
• Junior guard Nick Dorn chipped in eight points with two rebounds.
• Senior forward Reed Bailey added one point, one rebound and two assists.
• Junior guard Jasai Miles scored three points and knocked down his only shot of the night.
• Freshman forward Trent Sisley played three minutes.
• Up Next: IU will meet top-25 Michigan State on Sunday (March 1) afternoon at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. The game will be broadcasted to a national audience at 3:45 p.m. on CBS.
