## NOTABLES

- The Indiana Men's Basketball team (18-12, 9-10 BIG) returned to winning ways with a dominant 77-47 victory over Minnesota on Wednesday (March 4) evening at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall.
- IU converted on 10 made 3-point field goals. The Hoosiers have made double-digit baskets from beyond the arc on 20 occasions this year. They have knocked 10+ 3-point field goals in 13 conference contests this year.
- The Hoosiers 30-point win was the fifth win of the year by at least 30 points. It's the second of such in Big Ten play (+41 vs. Penn State, Dec. 9). It's the first time IU has allowed fewer than 50 points in a conference game since Jan. 14, 2023 vs. Wisconsin (45).
- Wednesday's win was the second victory of at least 30 points in Big Ten play. It's the first time IU has done so on multiple occasions in one year since 2015-16.
- Senior forward **Sam Alexis** went for 23 points on 9-of-11 shooting from the floor. He grabbed nine rebounds, finishing one away from a double-double.
- The big man recorded the first 20-point game of his IU career. In total, it was his most points since scoring 26 points during his time at Chattanooga.
- Fifth-year senior guard **Lamar Wilkerson** scored 16 points in the win, his 11th-straight game with at least 15 points. Tonight's game was the 14th time this year he's knocked down at least four 3-point field goals in a game.
- Wilkerson has scored 446 points during Big Ten play this season, the third-most points ever scored by a Hoosier in league play. With one conference game remaining, the Sam Houston State transfer trails just Don Schlundt (459 points) and Jimmy Rayl (454) on the all-time list.
- He is just the second player in program history (Steve Alford, 1986-87) to knock down 100 3-point field goals in a single season. He trails Alford by six on the all-time single season list ahead of Saturday's regular season finale.
- Redshirt senior forward **Tucker DeVries** provided 13 points, nine rebounds and five assists in the final home game of his college career.
- This was the 11th time in his career that DeVries has produced a game with at least 10 points, five rebounds and five assists. It's the first time he's done it since a win over Rutgers (Jan. 23).
- Junior guard **Nick Dorn** was the fourth starter to finish in double figures in Wednesday's win. He hit three 3-point field goals. Dorn also provided three rebounds in 28 minutes.
- Redshirt senior guard **Conor Enright** scored four points, grabbed five rebounds and dished out eight assists. He was a team-best +33 during his 33 minutes of action. It was his sixth game this year with at least eight assists.
- Junior guard **Jasai Miles** recorded two points.
- Senior forward **Reed Bailey** went for four points and three rebounds.
- Sixth-year senior guard **Tayton Conerway** scored two points.
- Freshman forward **Trent Sisley** added a pair of points.
- Up Next: IU will finish out the regular season on the road at Ohio State on Saturday (March 7). Tip is set for 5:30 p.m. on FOX from Columbus.
